

# Your Blizz account

You can create a free Blizz account in order to use the following functions:

- Synchronize your data on different devices
- Plan meetings
- Personal meeting ID

**Note:** you can use all other functions even without a Blizz account.

## Creating a Blizz account

1. Open **Blizz**.
2. Click **CREATE ACCOUNT**.
3. Enter the desired account data.

**Note:** the password must be at least 6 characters long and contain a capital letter, a lower-case letter, a number, and a special character.

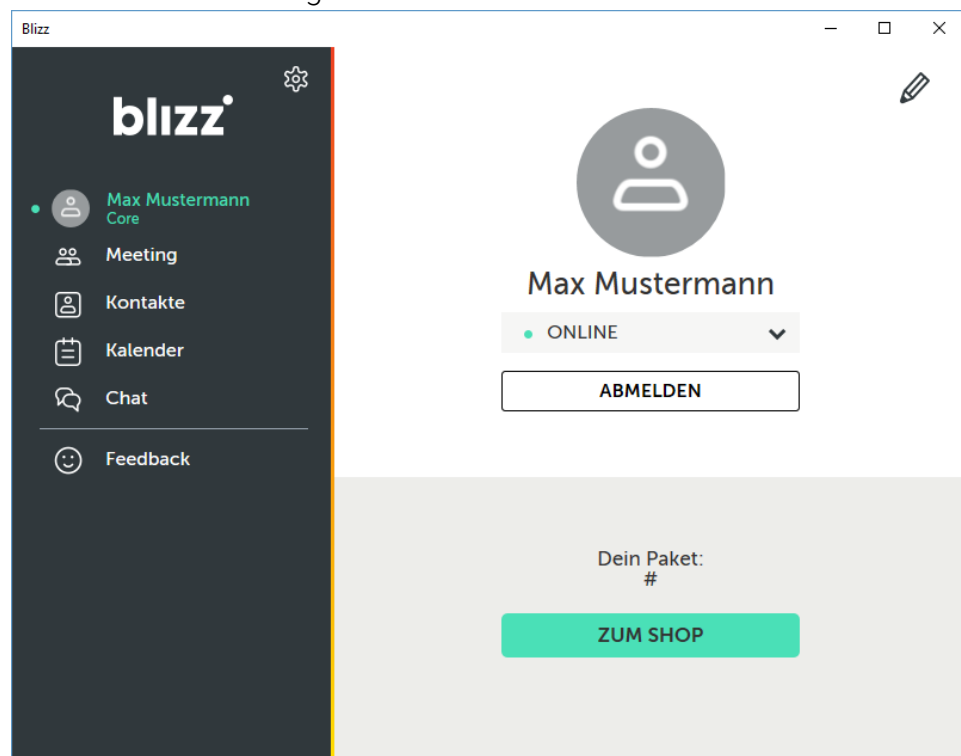

4. Click **CREATE ACCOUNT**.


That's all! The account is created and you will be logged in automatically with your account name. By default, your status is **ONLINE** after each login.



## Logging into you Blizz account

**Prerequisite:** you have already created a Blizz account.

1. Start **Blizz**.
2. Enter the account data that you wish to use to log in.

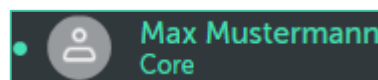
**Tip:** If you activate the **Stay logged in** check box, you do not have to log in anew each time.

## Logging out of your Blizz account

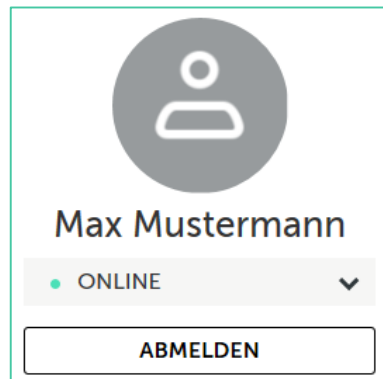
**Prerequisite:** you are logged in with your Blizz account.

1. On the navigation bar, click your user name.



2. Click **LOG OUT**.

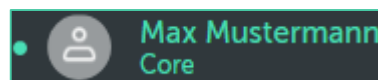


You will be logged out of your Blizz account.


## Changing Blizz settings

**Prerequisite:** you are logged in with your Blizz account.

1. On the navigation bar, click your user name.



Your profile page opens.

Click the pen icon  in the top right corner or click the gear wheel on the navigation bar and then click **Options**.

Here you can make the following settings for your profile:

→ **Profile:** profile settings such as name, e-mail, password

- **Meeting**: settings for meetings such as display quality and automatic recording
- **Audio conference**: settings for audio conference such as default devices and volume
- **Video**: settings for video source, e.g. driver settings and quality
- **Individual invitation**: template for invitation e-mail
- **Integrations**: options for Microsoft Office integrations
- **Manage contacts**: settings for the use of Outlook contacts
- **Advanced**: advanced settings such as proxy settings
